

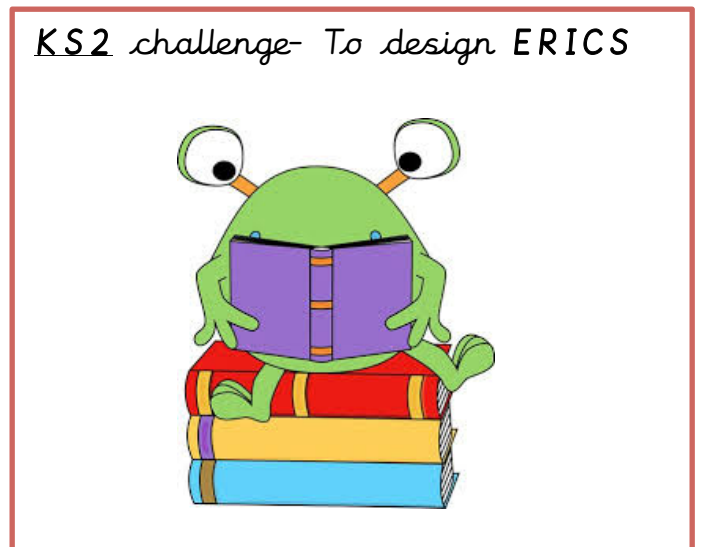
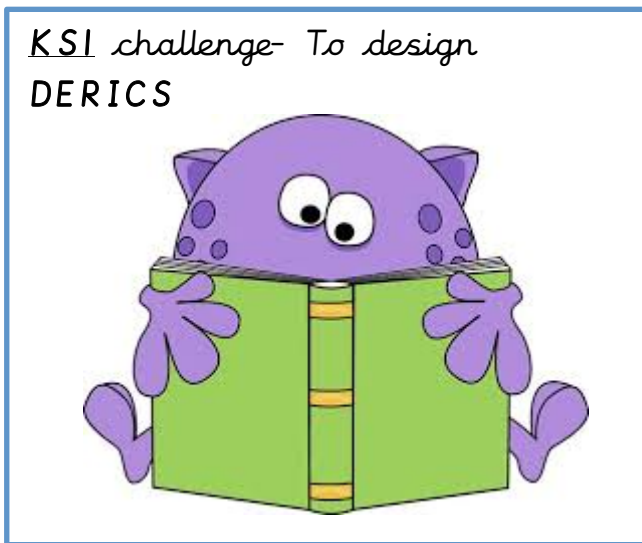
DERICS and ERICS

To make sure that you remember DERICS and ERICS, we need you to design a character that will represent them.



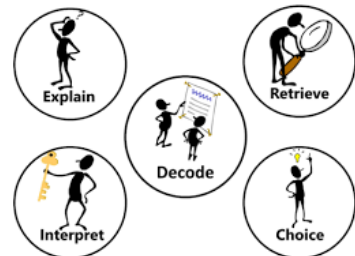
What will your character look like?


There will be a KS1 and a KS2 winner. Winning designs will be used in our school. Good luck!
